

The contractor knows that the customer is bound to the United Nations Global Compact and has adopted, in particular, a Guideline for Responsible Purchasing as an integral part of the “Responsible Purchasing” Group guideline.

The customer expects from its suppliers, in particular:

- to participate to the greatest extent possible in the development of the country they are operating in;
- to comply with the laws and regulations applicable in the countries they are operating in, as well as the standards defined by the International Labour Organization regarding workers' rights, especially in the areas of social security, working hours, working conditions and remuneration;
- to refrain from any kind of forced or compulsory labour or any kind of child labour;
- to take all steps required to ensure occupational health and safety; to have introduced a guideline for their own activities with the aim of identifying and preventing risks to health and safety; to inform the customer of all risks associated with their products or activities at the customer's sites; to introduce guidelines to design and improve their manufacturing processes in such a way that their ecological footprint will be minimised during the life cycle of the products delivered by them;
- to carry out their activities to such an extent that they are in line with the applicable national and international legal standards.
